all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at the intersection of Jenkins Street and Greene Avenue; thence N. 26° E. with said Greene Avenue 50 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction at nearly right angles to Greene Avenue and parallel to Jenkins Street 122 feet to a stake on line of lot of James Miller's; thence in a southeasterly direction along line of said lot 50 feet to Jenkins Street; thence with Jenkins Street 122 feet to the beginning corner being the same lot of land conveyed to Allen J.
