as Executrix of the last will of D. J. Smith, deceased  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Minnie Smith as Executrix of the last will of D. J. Smith, deceased, of Greenville County, subject to and in respect with the same conditions, limitations and requirements over to Gilbert C. Smith and Lulu C. Smith as is contained in the will of D. J. Smith deceased. Said will being admitted to probate on the 1st day of February, 1926, by Probate in, and for Greenville County, residence being thereto had a will more fully (apart from all that piece of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Town of Creek on Maynard Street having the following bounds, beginning at an iron pipe on Maynard Street 135 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 78-1/2 E. 160 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 11-1/4 E. 93 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 68-1/4 W. 160 feet to the beginning corner, being designated as Lot No. 17, and 18 of a plat of land called Brookville, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J.
