the Greenville Branch, on the west side
of the South Carolina Road, in the County and
District of Spartanburg, beginning at a stone, and
running thence S. 65° 30' W. 16 rods to a stone;
thence S. 65° 30' E. 12 rods to a stone; thence S. 26° 30'
E. 10 rods to a stone; thence N. 26° 30' E. 10 rods to a stone;
thence N. 26° 30' E. 10 rods to the beginning corner
surrounded by lands of Mr. W. H. Goodlett, Preston
Branch, and others, containing forty (40) acres,
more or less, and being the property
owned by myself, to Belle Morgan by A. T. Kitebread
by deed dated 15th December 1902 and
recorded in Vol. 650, page 222.
