All the Piece, Parcel or tract of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, S. C. containing 75 acres, more or less, and bounded now or formerly by lands of the estate of J. W. Baker Brooks Mahaffey and of Arch Burnett, lying on the Enoree River, about 1 1/2 miles from the Greenville Court House, and being the same conveyed to me by C. Inman, Master in the action of Ezell Smith, et al., vs. Elijah Benson, et al. Reserving, however, unto myself and my wife Ada Smith the income and control thereof during my natural life, and should my said wife survive me, then a support to her during her natural life or widowhood; but after my death the control and possession thereof to go immediately to my children already named as grantees herein.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Richcous Smith, Worthy Smith, Pearl Terry, Ethel Butler, and Tweety Smith, in their respective heirs and assigns, forever, subject to the reservations above made.

AND I, Ezell Smith, do hereby bind my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Richcous Smith, Worthy Smith, Pearl Terry, Ethel Butler, and Tweety Smith, in their respective heirs and assigns, against all claims, demands, suits, and

my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
