All that certain piece, parcel or strip of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, said strip of land being an alley fifteen (15) feet in width, extending from Vernon Street to Bennett Street and running parallel with Park Avenue and Poinsett Avenue, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, said Plat recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "B", page 11, to wit:
