at and before the sealing of these presents by R. M. Shamburss

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
R. M. Shamburss all that certain lot of land situated lying and  
being in style and boundary aforesaid and on the waters  
of North Saluda River. This lot of land was originally in  
two tracts. The first tract begins at a cucumber tree on  
the east bank of a creek and East side of the Saluda  
Limestone road it being Jordan Salcombe corner and runs  
thence S. 24° 12' E. 18 poles crossing said creek and road  
to a small poplar; thence S. 4° W. 21 poles to a rock  
on the South East side of the road; thence N. 61° East  
5 poles to the mouth of the Dale hollow branch; thence  
up the said branch with its meanderings 26 poles to a  
rock in fork of same; thence N. 8° E. 50 1/2 poles to a  
rock; thence N. 45° E. 62 1/2 to a chestnut oak John Ward's  
corner; thence with his line N. 1° E. 39 1/2 poles to a rock  
on the line of the old Thompson tract; thence with  
said line S. 83° W. 97 poles to a rock near a small  
branch; thence S. 3° W. with Salcombe line 56 poles to the  
beginning and contains 5 1/2 acres more or less. The  
second or other tract lying and being aforesaid state  
and County on the head waters of Bell creek of  
North Saluda river. Beginning at a rock, Hick's corner  
and corner of John Ward's land and runs N. 24 W. with  
said John Ward's line 16 poles to a rock at Thompson  
Ward's fence; thence with said fence S. 62 W. 6 poles to  
a rock; thence S. 72 1/2 W. 30 1/2 poles to a stake at  
a small branch; thence down said branch S. 10 W.  
9 poles to a stake on the old Thompson line;  
thence with said line N. 80 E. 43 poles to the beginning  
corner and contains 2 3/4 acres more or less. Being  
the same lots of land sold to J. W. Burress and  
wife E. C. Burress by Daniel Hick's in deed bearing  
date of December 7th 1906 and recorded in office of  
R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 000 page 13. Reference  
is hereby made to said deed for a full description  
being the same lots of land held by us as the only  
children and heirs of J. W. Burress and wife E. C. Burress  
deceased, and we are both 21 years of age.
