Office for said County in Plat Book F., at pp. 66 - 67. The said lot has the following metes and bounds: beginning at a stake on said Oregon Street 60 feet east of the corner of Mitchell Street, at corner of Lot #1 of said Block, and running thence along said Street N. 63-30 E. sixty feet to stake at corner of Lot #3; thence along, said lot S. 26-30 E. one hundred and sixty-five feet to a stake at rear; thence S. 63-30 W. sixty feet to stake at cor. of lot #1; thence along said lot, N. 26-30 W. one hundred and Sixty-five feet to the beginning point on said Oregon Street.
