aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, in the subdivision known as "Kanatenah", and known as
Lot #15, of Block "E" on revised plat of the said property to be recorded in the R.M.C.
Office for said County.

The said lot has the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the South side of
Cureton Street, at corner of lot #14, and running thence along said Street 60 feet to stake at
corner of Lot #16; thence along said lot, 150 feet to stake at corner of lot #7; thence along
said lot, 60 feet to stake at corner of lot #14; thence along said lot 150 feet to the
beginning point on Cureton Street.
