All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and be-  
ing in the First Ward of the City of Greenville County and  
State, aforesaid on the East Side of Laurens Street, Land be-  
ing known and designated as lot No. 2 of the property of  
Anderson, McMissick and Parish according to a plat  
made by P. E. Dalton, Engineer, January 1923, and having  
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds  
to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Laurens St.  
60 feet South of the south east corner of Laurens and Col-  
lege Streets, and running thence S. 55° 55' E. 60 ft. to an  
iron pin in line of lot No. 1; thence with the line com-  
mon to lots Nos. 1 and 2, S. 21° 05' 21.30 ft. to an iron pin  
in line of lot No. 3; thence with the joint line of lots Nos.  
2 and 3 N. 55° 55' 21.60 feet to an iron pin on Laurens Street,
