(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Olive Garrison and St. Jack Goodman,
the said certain lot, situate, lying and being
in Greenville County, County and State aforesaid
near the City of Greenville, between and designated as
lot 20 of the 2nd Division known as Augusta Circle
as shown in a plat of record in the R. M. C. Office
of Greenville County. Located between the Pease Boarding House
and Shandy according to said plat the following
metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the
southern side of East Augusta Drive, the front corner
of lot 20, 80 yards 40 and running thence with the
front line of lot 154.4 feet to an iron pin on
the same lot 20, 88; thence in a westerly direction
with the line of lot 20, 88. 45.76 feet to an iron pin,
the front corner of lot 20, 90 and 91; thence in a
northerly direction with the joint line of lots 20, 90
to 100.5 feet to an iron pin on said west
