(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the

as aforesaid: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Greenville Township, just outside the City
limits of the City of Greenville, on Hampton Avenue Extension, and having the following metes
and bounds according to a survey made by R.E. Dalton, Eng. to-wit:

Commencing at a stake on the North side of Hampton Avenue Ext., said stake being at the
northwest corner of Hampton Ave. Ext. and a thirty foot lot; thence along the north side of
Hampton Ave. Ext. 64-30 W. 294 feet to a stake at the northwest corner of Hampton Ave.
