in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Sallie H. Thomas, her heirs and assigns forever:-

"All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Bounded on the North by Lot No. 2; on the East by Mary A. Hawkins; on the South by Lot No. 3, and West by Reedy River, and known as Lot No. 1 in the survey made by J. K. Dickson, Surveyor, dated March 9th, 1888., containing fifty seven (57) acres, more or less, the respective locations and the metes and bounds of the above lot herein conveyed are fully shown in a plat of the same on file in the office of the R.
