the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

R. M. Henry and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, All that piece, parcel and tract of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, beginning at a stone on N. A. Henderson's line and running thence N. 27 E. 20.20 to stake on Cripple Creek thence down the meanderings of said creek as the line 17.75 chains to stake; thence S. 83 W. 2.90 chains to stake in bottom; thence N. 58 1/2 W. 15.25 chains to small pine in bottom; thence N. 77 W. 11.70 chains to stake on creek; thence S. 27 3/4 W. 10.69 chains to stone on lands formerly owned by Cely; thence with the Cely line S. 67 3/4 E. 42.34 chains to the beginning corner; containing 58 1/4 acres, more or less, and being the same land conveyed to F.
