All that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County aforesaid State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, Beginning at the point 200 feet North of the Southwest corner of Wilton Street and Randall Street, and running thence N. 1-41 E. 133 1/3 feet to a stake, thence in a line parallel with said Wilton Street S. 1-41 W. 133 1/3 feet to a stake, thence running thence S. 83-13 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner, same being connected to D. 1st.
