the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
into the said.

W. R. Cason and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:  
All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville,  
S. C. Beginning at a stake on the East side of Center Street, and running thence along said  
Street S. 15 W. 30 feet to a stake; thence S. 77-30 E. 67.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 10-40  
E. 30 feet to a stake; thence N. 77-30 W. 66.2 feet to the beginning corner. Being known as  
Lot No. 41 on a plat of Peagan & Moseley subdivision of Richland Creek, made by R. E. Dalton  
July 1911.
