Cox, Royal Box & others, to enter upon, to inspect, to repair, to alter, to change, to renew, to extend, to shorten, to cut away and keep clear of all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same, and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises a copper messenger wire, poles, towers, wires, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right, at all times, to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations theron, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.
