in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and State  
aforesaid, and having the following lines and bounds:  
Beginning at a point in the West line of Gay Street  
310 ft. from the corner of East Washington Road and Gay  
Street, the Northeast corner of lot No. 15, runs thence with  
the line of lot No. 15, S. 15-0 W. 134.8 ft. to an alley, the corner  
of lot No. 15, thence with the alley N. 13-15 W. 5.6 ft. to a  
corner of lot No. 17, thence with the line of said lot  
N. 15-0 E. 33.1 ft. to Gay street, the corner of lot No. 17, thence  
with the line of Gay street, S. 15-0 E. 55 ft. to the begin-  
ning, the said lot bearing No. 16 on a plat of the property

title of this tract shall revert to the grantor, except as to  
lien creditors.
