Agreement to close alley.

Whereas, on a plat of the Stone Land Company, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., Plat Book "A", Page 341, in Section "B", there is one block bounded by Wilton, Randall, Robinson and Croft Streets, said block consisting of lots Nos. 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 26, 29 and 30; that lots have frontages on Croft and Randall Streets, respectively, of One hundred and eight and nine-tenths (108.9) feet with depths of Two hundred (200) feet back to a sixteen (16) foot alley, as shown on said
