which are not conditions subsequent, but are to be deemed covenants running with the land and binding all owners and occupants thereof. They may be enforced by appropriate proceedings by any owner or occupant of any lot of land shown on said plat, as well as by this grantor, since they are for the benefit of all persons in the neighborhood. By accepting this deed, said grantee binds himself and his heirs and assigns to comply with all of said conditions.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself as trustee for Mrs. H.D. Wilkins, and its successors, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named and his heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof through or under said granting corporation.
