Gower (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), and for divers other good and valuable considerations, do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower, and do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns unto the said W.D. Parrish and T.C. Gower and their heirs and assigns as follows:

- (1) That no fence shall be erected on any portion of either of the two lots hereinafter described within forty (40) feet of Elm Street.
