I, Mrs. Rosa Guest, nee Queen, do hereby and by these presents, relinquish, sell, convey and assign to John A. Guest, his heirs, successors, administrators or assigns, all rights, title, claim, interest and demand in and to any and all personal and real property now owned, or in possession of the said John A. Guest, or that may hereafter be acquired by him, together with all claims or rights for dower or support and maintenance.

I, John A. Guest, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, to me in hand paid by Mrs. Rosa Guest, nee Queen, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the further considerations above mentioned, do hereby and by these presents, sell, convey, consign, release and relinquish unto Mrs. Rosa Guest, nee Queen, all and every right, title, claim, interest, property, possession and demand in any and all real and personal property now held or may hereafter be acquired by her in her own separate name, in every species of property, real or personal, of every kind and nature, wheresoever the same may be located.

And the parties hereto do hereby severally bind themselves, their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns to the full and complete compliance of the above conveyance and agreement. Witness our separate and respective hands and seals at the places and times as noted:
