In case either party should neglect, after five days' notice, to appoint an arbitrator, the other party shall have the right to apply to a Judge of the County Court or of the Court of Common Please for Greenville County for the appointment of an arbitrator, who shall act as though he had been appointed by the party in default. In case the leases should fail to comply with the sward of the arbitrators for a period of thirty days, the lessor shall have the right to sue on said award or to declere the less terminated and retake the premises.

Nothing contained in this lease shall prevent the leasor from erecting any building on its lots fronting on tain Street adjoining said hotel building, and in case of a construction of any such building, nothing herein contained shall prevent the leasor from having the right to tie on to the Northern wall of said Hotel Suilding. Provided that if such building shall exceed one story in height, an air space of twenty feet shall be made above the first story.
