Know all men by these presents that Title Guarantee and Trust Company (a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in said County and State) as Trustee, for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred and fifty dollars to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. R. Hart Jr., and D. P. Campbell, share and share alike, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, at or near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lot numbered sixteen (16) on a plat of Mrs H. D. Wilkins property made by R. E. Dalton, dated March, 1924, to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "F" at page 209, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning at an iron pipe on the north-east corner of Laddson and Otis Streets, and running thence along said Otis Street N. 72° E. one hundred and seventy (170) feet to an iron pipe on the corner of lot number fifteen; thence with line of last mentioned lot N. 15° 45' W. sixty-three and five one-hundredths (63.05) feet to an iron pipe on joint corner of lots fourteen, fifteen, sixteen and seventeen; thence S. 72° W. one hundred and sixty-five and eight-tenths (65.8) feet along line of lot number seventeen to an iron pipe on Laddson Street, thence with Laddson Street S. 11° 57' E. sixty-three and thirty-six one-hundredths (63.36) feet to the beginning corner, this being a part of the tract of land conveyed to said Title Guarantee and Trust Company as Trustee, by Mrs Harriet D. Wilkins by deed bearing date January 31, 1924, and recorded, in Book page 199. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named and their heirs and assigns forever, subject, however, to the following restrictions and conditions, to wit:

(1) Said lot shall be used exclusively for residential purposes for white persons only (except as to servants of occupants) and shall never be sold, rented or otherwise.

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disposed of to any person wholly or partly of African descent, or used in any manner which may render neighboring property undesirable for residential purposes.

(2) No building (other than outbuildings appertaining to a dwelling) costing less than three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) shall be erected on said lot; nor shall any building be erected thereon within twenty-five (25) feet of Laddson Street.

Any dwelling erected on said lot shall face Laddson Street, and said lot shall not be re-cut nor subdivided so as to face in any other direction.

(3) No surface, closet or cesspool shall ever be used on said land; but only septic tanks or other sanitary sewers.

The purchase price of said land has been reduced materially because of the foregoing conditions, which are not conditions subsequent, but are to be deemed covenants running with the land and binding all owners and occupants thereof. They may be enforced by appropriate proceedings by any owner or occupant of any lot of land shown on said plat, as well as by this grantor, since they are for the benefit of all persons in the neighborhood. By accepting this deed, each grantee binds himself and his heirs and assigns to comply with all of said conditions.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself as trustee for Mrs H. D. Wilkins, and its successors, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantees hereinabove named and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof through or under said granting corporation.

In witness whereof the said granting corporation has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by L. O. Patterson, its President and Treasurer (being duly authorized thereto) on this the fourth day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, and in the one hundred and forty-eighth year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America.
