A. Gudger of Asheville, North Carolina, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the
said Herman A. Gudger, his heirs, and assigns, the
right to go in and upon that tract of land,
situated in Bates Township, in said County and
State, bounded by lands of North by S. S. Eppes; and
Tom Guest, East by lands of S. S. Eppes; on the South
by lands of Herman Gudger, west by tracts of J. L.
Eppes. And to construct and maintain upon said
premises a pipe line for the purpose of conveying
water through premises above described, together with
the right at all times to enter upon said
premises for the purpose of making necessary repairs.
The owner has the same privileges and rights to
cultivate and use the land as he had prior to
this agreement. The payment above specified is
accepted in full settlement for the said right
of way.
