Good, May Good wood and Alma Good Turner, of Belford County N. C., in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred dollars to be in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. G. Good, Jr. (The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. G. Good, Jr., his heirs and assigns forever; all our undivided interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Cleveland Township, in the County of Greenville and in the state of South Carolina, adjoining lands of W. G. Batson, Cleveland and others, containing six acres, more or less, described as follows, lying on the west side of Gap Creek Road on waters of Middle Saluda River:

Beginning on a red oak between road and Creek; thence N. 18° 47.40 to stone; thence N. 30 E. 3.50 to stone, Cleveland's line; thence N. 41 E. with Cleveland's line 7.67 to a stake; thence N. 50 E. with Cleveland's line 8.10 to stone in Gap Creek Road; thence a south-west direction with said road 15.53 to the beginning, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Valentine G. Good, Sr. by Flora T. Wade by deed dated Sept. 25th 1894. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
