County of Greenville and City of Greenville, on the East side of South Main Street, and

and Broad Streets, and running thence approximately South seventy (70) degrees East with South  
side of said alley eighty-one (81) feet to an iron pin; thence approximately North eighty  
(80) degrees East forty-four and five-tenths (44.5) feet to an iron pin; thence approximately  
South seventy (70) degrees East two hundred and thirty-nine and three-tenths (239.3) feet to  
an iron pin; the corner of said alley and west of Falls Street, this corner being ten (10)  
feet South of Jail lot; thence with West side of Falls Street approximately South nineteen  
(19) degrees West two hundred twenty-six and nine-tenths (226.9) feet to an iron pin, the  
Northeast corner of J.Z. Phillips lot; thence with said Phillips line and others approximately
