at and before the sealing of these presents by Hobt. J. Woodside, of Greenville, S.C.

This instrument is fully acknowledged, Received, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Hobt. J. Woodside all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and about three miles from the City of Greenville, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at a stone on branch on the corner of the Coffey property, the said point of beginning being the Northwest corner of the tract of land conveyed by G.B. Cunningham to G.L. Walker on deed dated February 13, 1922, and recorded in Book 73 at page 456 in the Office of the R.R.C. for Greenville County, State aforesaid, and running thence N. 8-1/3 deg. West along the Western line of the tract of land sold to Walker as aforesaid, Five hundred twenty-seven and 72/100 (527.72) feet to the Northwest corner of a certain tract of land conveyed by G.L. Walker to G.B. Cunningham by deed dated August 19, 1922, and recorded in Book 78, at page 270 in said R.R.C. Office; thence running North 62 deg. 53 min. East twelve feet to a stone; thence South 8-1/3 deg. East Five hundred twenty-seven and 72/100 (527.72) feet, across the branch, to a stake at the Southwest corner of the property owned by G.B. Cunningham, and deeded this day to Hobt. J. Woodside; thence South 73 deg. West twelve feet to the point of beginning. It is the intention of this deed to convey a strip of land twelve feet in width, adjoining and immediately West of the property owned by Cunningham and conveyed to Hobt. J. Woodside as aforesaid, which strip of land extends fully the entire West side of said property formerly owned by Cunningham.

For value received the Piedmont Savings & Trust Co. of Greenville, S.C. does hereby release and forever discharge the property described in the within written deed from the lion of that certain mortgage executed by G.L. Walker to Piedmont Savings & Trust Co. for \$5000.00 which mortgage is dated Dec. 6th, 1922, and is recorded in the R.R.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Book 89 at page 41; said corporation is the owner and holder of said mortgage.
