Railroad and on the south side of St. John street, and being known and designated as lot No. 2 of the estate of Ella Evelyn as shown by plan of said property, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pier on south side of St. John street 36.4 feet from the center of the C. & G. division of the Southern Railroad and running thereof S. 33-10 W. 107.8 feet to a stake in line of Evelyn Road property; thence along line of last mentioned property N. 75-18 E. 37 feet to an iron pier, corner off lot No. 1 thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 16-38 E. 102.4 feet to an iron pier in line of St. John street; thence S. 75-15 E. 67.5 feet to the beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed to J.
