at and before the sealing of these presents by H. J. Goodwin, Jr.(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
H. J. Goodwin, Jr. all that certain lot of land situated
in the aforesaid place of the corporate limits of
the town of Greenville on the East side of Bonestee
avenue, and being further more described in lot No.
13 of the plat map of the town of Greenville as shown
on the flat model of the town of Greenville, 1923, and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County
in Plat Book 1 at page 136, order bearing the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:Beginning at a stake on the East side of Bonestee
avenue at corner of lot No. 21, and running thence
with the line of lot No. 21 S. 62-50 E. 180 feet to
stake, thence with line of lot No. 23 S. 27-10 W. 70
feet to stake, thence with line of lot No. 25 N.
62-50 W. 180 feet to stake on Bonestee Avenue, thence
with Bonestee Avenue N. 27-10 W. 70 feet to beginning
point, being one of the lots conveyed by Margaret
St. Pierre to H. D. Parrish, J. C. Powers and W. A. Givens
by deed recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County Volume 90 page 35, the interest of W. A. Givens
being subsequently conveyed to H. D. Parrish by
deed recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville
County in Volume 91, page 395.Nevertheless, upon the following conditions, which
conditions are part of the consideration for this deed
and are expressly for the benefit of the owner of
lot as shown on plat above referred to to-wit:
(1) No building shall be erected nearer to the
abutting sidewalk than thirty (30) feet.
(2) The property herein conveyed shall never be sold
rented, or otherwise disposed of to a person, or persons,
having a percentage of negro blood.
(3) The property herein conveyed shall never be
used for other than residential purposes, and no
residence costing less than thirty-five thousand (\$35,000)
Dollars shall ever be erected thereon.TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
appertaining.TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said H. J. Goodwin, Jr.

AND H. J. Goodwin, Jr. do hereby bind
himself, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said H. J. Goodwin, Jr.heirs and assigns, against
all and singular, the claims, demands, and
