and heretofore Purchaser, James A. Westcott, his heirs  
and successors, all that certain tract or parcel of land situate  
in the city of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having  
thereon a building thereon situated, on the 25th day of January  
one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, and containing  
acres, which lands are described to  
beginning at the corner of a line running  
from the corner of the intersection of West  
Washington Street and running north  
with West Washington Street N. 52-39' E. go east  
to an iron hook on the south side of a few feet  
wide, thence northwards along the same line, N. 52-39' E.  
to a bent fence post in front corner of  
lot 10, corner with the front line of said  
lot S. 22-53' W. go east to an iron hook on the north  
side of West Washington Street, thence with said  
street to the fence, N. 52-39' E. to the beginning  
corner, this being part of the property
