Hartness, her heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin, on corner of lots nos. 16 and 20, on Donny Brook St. and running thence with the line of lot nos. 19 and 20, 126 feet to a stake on an alley, thence with the Donny Brook St. 75 feet to a stake in the line of lot nos. 13 and 19, thence with line of lot nos. 13 and 19 to an iron pin on Donny Brook St. thence with the property line on Donny Brook St. to the beginning corner and being a portion of lot nos. 19 & a sub division more fully set forth in a plat recorded in Plat Book 6, at page 95, and known as M.C. Collough Heights, said Plat being hereby referred to for a more complete description. Land is made a part of this conveyance.
