the witness whereof acknowledge, have granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said C. M. Blaythe, as Trustee for Walter L. Grawaway, his successors and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and being a portion of block "F" of the property herein as hereinafter described, as shown in plat of said property recorded in the office of the C. M. C. of Greenville & County in plat book 6 at page 10 (a strip 75 feet in width) and approximately 410 feet in length on the North side of said block "F" and included in block "F" as shown in plat above referred to, being now covered by the extension of First Avenue eastward to the line of H. M. Street in the direction of Main Street) and having the following lines and bounds according to said plat.
 Beginning at a stake on south side of First Avenue 310 feet inward from the east side of First Street, running 100 feet eastward from fifteen foot alley shown in said plat, and being on the southwest corner of the 75 foot strip of block "F" now covered by said extension of First Avenue and running thence S. 80° 15' E. along the said extension of First Avenue 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 80° 15' E. 180 feet to a stake; thence N. 9° 45' E. 180 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same property conveyed to me by J. E. Burdon by deed dated May 19, 1923 recorded in the office of the C. M. C. for Greenville County in deed book 90 at page 25, as a part of the consideration of this conveyance, the grantee hereby agrees and agrees to pay a certain mortgage executed to C. W. Graway by J. E. Burdon, dated the 17th day of April, 1923, in the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and covering the within described lot of land.
