the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said,

The White Oak Poultry Farms its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Greenville, County said state aforesaid, and on the west side of Hedge street and being known and designated as lot No. 25 as shown on the sub-division and plat of the estate of S. J. Wilson made by W. J. Riddell Surveyor in August 1923, said Riddell surveying metes and bounds and corners and distances, as shown in said plat, to wit: Beginning at a point on the west side of Hedge street at the northeast corner of said lot and running thence along the line of the Burdett land S. 167 W. 122 feet thence N. 162.30 E. 3 feet to the southeast corner of lot No. 25 thence along the line of last mentioned lot S. 77 E. 25 feet to the northeast corner of lot No. 3; thence along the line of said lot N. 3.
