and his heirs and assigns forever all that lot of land in the City and County of

Greenville, known as lot No. 14, Block 2, as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book "E"

Page 242 of the records of Greenville County, and which fronts 70 feet on Eagle Street

and runs back in parallel lines to a depth of 150 feet. This lot was conveyed to O. B.

Van Wyck by H. K. Townes.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and the remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said *O. B. Van Wyck*.

and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said premises with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto the said *Henry T. Townes* Heirs and Assigns forever.
