TOGETHER with the rights, privileges and benefits that could be exercised by us as parents, over and in respect to the said Merritt James Worley III and Mary Jean Worley.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said Merritt James Worley III and Mary Jean Worley against ourselves and any and all persons claiming or to claim any interest, right or privilege through us or any person in and to the said Merritt James Worley III and Mary Jean Worley.
