Witnesseth: that for and in consideration of the mutual covenants passing between the parties hereto, the party of the first part and the parties of the second part agree to accept tract No. 3 containing eight acres as designated on plat of D. B. Hunt thereto attached and made a part hereof in full settlement of all their claims under the said last will and testament of Louisa Thompson; the parties of the third part hereby agree to accept tract No. 2 containing four acres as per said plat, in full settlement of their claims under the said last will and testament of Louisa Thompson; the parties of the fourth part hereby agree to accept tract No. 1 containing four acres as per said plat, in full settlement of their claims under the said last will and testament of Louisa Thompson; and the party of the fifth part agrees to accept the sum of one hundred and thirty nine dollars (\$139.00) in full settlement to her claims under the last will and testament, the parties of the first, second, third and fourth part hereby agreeing to pay their pro rata share thereof in the amount of thirty four dollars and eighty five cents each.

It is further covenanted and agreed between the parties hereto that each released to the other all their right, title and interest in and to the other all their right, title and interest in and to the respective tracts of said land as hereinabove divided.
