

thence S. 86° W. approximately 55.29 chrs to a stone S. 52° 40' E. approximately 20 chrs to a stone, thence S. 23° 52' W. 10.44 chrs to a corner thence crossing the road and Devil's Fork Creek, 20.30 chrs approximately to the stone, thence N. 55° 49' E. 47.47 chrs to the beginning corner.

(4) All to the timber and trees, together with all the rights of way, privileges to the Grantor herein following, on that certain parcel of land containing 44 acres more or less, and shown on a plat prepared for Elinda Land and Lumber Company by J. W. Mullins, R. E. Survey 1918-1922, as "No. 6-X-III," J. W. Mullins' reference to which plat is hereby saved for a full and complete description thereof, all the rights herein conveyed are to be set forth, and subject to all the restrictions and limitations contained in that certain deed, executed by J. W. Mullins to R. E. Johnson dated September 29, 1913, recorded in the R. M. G. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 9, page 890 which title was subsequently deeded to the Grantor herein, it being the intent of the said Grantor to convey unto the said Grantee all of their timber, timber rights, right-of-way and easements which rights, ways and easements expire September 29, 1928, and to the following described property to-wit:

To have and to hold, all and singular, the said premises, timber, trees, rights, ways, privileges, and easements unto the said H. T. Hawkins, Grantee, his heirs and assigns, for the full term, time and period as hereinbefore specifically set forth as to each and every tract, for the cutting and removal of the said timber and trees and enjoyment of all other rights granted hereunder.

And the said Saluda Land and Lumber Company, Grantor, does hereby bind itself, its successors and assigns, to warrant and defend all and singular, the said timber, trees, rights, ways, and easements hereinabove

granted and conveyed unto the said H. T. Hawkins, his heirs and assigns for the full term, time and period herein specified, against itself, its successors and assigns and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same through, by, or under it.
