State of South Carolina, Release of Dower.  
County of Greenville.

This Release of Dower made by Mrs. Emma (E.S.) Griffin, wife of E.S. Griffin, hereinafter called party of the second part, to E.S. Griffin, husband of said Mrs. Emma (E.S.) Griffin, his heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, grantees and devisees, hereinafter called the party of the first part.

Whereas an agreement was entered into on the 28th day of June 1910 between E.S. Griffin, party of the first part, and Mrs. Emma (E.S.) Griffin, party of the second part, which agreement is recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Deed Book "QQQ" at page 43 1/2, reference to which is hereby craved for the detailed agreement. Said agreement provided that the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000) dollars was to be paid by the estate of the party of the first part to the party of the second part at his death or as soon thereafter as practical, and she, the party of the second part, agreed to accept said Two Thousand (\$2000.) Dollars in full settlement of any and all claims she might have against his estate, and especially in full satisfaction and bar of dower to which she was, or might become entitled.

Whereas the said party of the second part is desirous of having the above mentioned sum of Two thousand (\$2000.) Dollars paid over to her at this time rather than at the death of said party of the first part, so that she may use the interest on said money, and the money itself as she pleases, and whereas the party of the first part is willing to pay same over to her on the conditions and limitations set out in above referred to agreement, reference to which is hereby craved.

Now know all men by these presents That I, Mrs. Emma (E.S.) Griffin, party of the second part, and wife of E.S. Griffin, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.) dollars which has this day been paid and given to me by E.S. Griffin, party of the first part, receipt for which is hereby acknowledged, have released and forever discharged, and by these presents do for me, my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, grantees and devisees, remise, release and forever discharge the said E.S. Griffin, his heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, grantees and devisees from any claim or claims I may have or hereafter have against him, his heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, grantees and devisees, of any kind whatsoever, and especially do I accept the above consideration -

in full satisfaction and bar dower to which I might be entitled to out of the freehold hereditaments of or to which the said E.S. Griffin is, or shall be during coverture, be seized or entitled.
