unto me, the state aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. J. Welborne the certain parcel or tract of land situated upon and being in Franklin Township, County of Greenville and State aforesaid and described as follows: Beginning at a pine stump corner first, a stone opposite to front of the road leading to house on the north side of Old Highway, being an established corner of W. J. Bruce, thence N. 89° 45' E. one hundred twenty-eight feet (678) to iron corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. three hundred and eighty feet (386) to stone corner, big pine stump on southwest side of old road, thence S. 13° 34' W. eight hundred and twenty-six feet (826) to stone corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. two hundred and sixteen feet (216) to iron corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. three hundred and eighty feet (386) to stone corner, thence S. 13° 34' W. eight hundred and forty-eight feet (488) to stone corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. three hundred and six feet (306) to stones and stone corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. eight hundred and forty-eight feet (488) to stone corner, thence S. 71° 15' E. three hundred sixteen and five tenths feet (416.5) to stone corner, thence N. 12° W. eighty-nine and five tenths feet (89.5) to white oak corner, thence N. 67° 14' E. one thousand and fifty-nine feet (159) to stone corner, thence S. 64° 38' E. two hundred and forty-five feet (245) to beginning corner.
