the receipt whereof a copy whereof ~~have~~ Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Olive Jeannette Andrea (she already being of a two twenty-first interest), All our rights, title, interests and estate (the same being an undivided nineteenth twenty-first interest in lands, tenements, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, and being more specifically described as follows:

First: That parcel of land known as Tract No. 1 of the P.L. Andrea Estate as surveyed and platted by V.A. Hester and dated on the plat as of July the 9th, 1926, being a part of the home tract and known as the "Abercrombie Place" having metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at an I.P. on the corner of tracts number 1 and 2 at a corner with the Mrs. Mary Bearden land and running N. 62-1/2 E. 6.42 along a local public road to a post oak on the south side of said road; thence S. 47 E. 4.01 to a stone being the corner of the William Collins lands; thence S. 44 E. 11.78 to a poplar stump on the west bank of a branch; thence S. 12-1/2 E. 11.84 to a stake in a branch; thence S. 59-1/2 W. 6.00 along an abandoned road to an angle in said road; thence S. 47 W. 11.90 to a pile of rock on the corner of the M.E. Fowler lands; thence N. 13 W. 24.52 to a stone being the corner of Tract No. 4 and the M.E. Fowler land; thence N. 45-37 W. 11.42 to the beginning corner, containing 10.55 acres, more or less.

Second: One piece, parcel or lot of land lying about two miles northeast of Greenville City in the Perry Road and designated as lots 4 and 5 of Block One on a plat dated May 14, 1914 by A.S. Badell, Surveyor, of a certain subdivision of land known as "Newland" and being a part of the land conveyed to the late P.L. Andrea by A.G. New by deed dated October 11, 1914 and recorded in the R.M.C.'s office in Vol. 36, page 253. This lot of land has a frontage of 100 feet and a depth of 150 feet and a back of 100 feet. This is subject to the limitations of the original deed.

Third: All those certain pieces or lots of land lying about three miles from the Greenville County Court House and designated as Lots 22-23-24-33-34-35 and 36 of the P.L. Andrea land platted and dated July 18, 1926 by V.A. Hester, Surveyor, and recorded in the Book of Plats in the S.V.C.'s office and being a portion of that tract of land containing Ten acres conveyed to the late P.L. Andrea by R.P. McGee, W.P. Conyers and W.A. Henderson, Trustees by a deed dated Nov. 6, 1916 and recorded in the R.M.C.'s office in Vol. 40 on page 256.

This conveyance is subject to the rights of the public in all road ways designated on the plat.

This conveyance is made in order to make a settlement of the Estate of Redmond L. Andrea, deceased July 11, 1921, between his legal heirs, all being of legal age and consisting of his widow, Celestine S. Andrea, and his seven surviving children as follows: Leonardo Andrea, Myrtle Andrea Roberts, Agnes Andrea Cribb, Olive J. Andrea, Frank A. Andrea, Connie Lee Andrea and Willie May Andrea.
