In witness whereof I, the undersigned, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. F. Campbell, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in the said lot of land, bounded as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of lot no. 17 on Snow Street and Harrison Street S. 84-58 E. 6 feet to the corner of lot 18, thence S. 20-31 E. 15 feet to the corner of lot 19, S. 70-52 E. 25 and 26, thence N. 70-54 W. 60 feet to the corner of lot 17 and 27; thence S. 20-31 E. 15 feet to the beginning corner, same being designated as lot number 118 on Hollwood Street, inhabited by W. H. Willis and known as the Holtzclaw property, on Jan. 19, 1916.
