KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A. W. Beauchight of Greenville County

at and before the sealing of these presents by William Goldsmith

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said William Goldsmith his heirs and assigns forever,  
all those two certain pieces parcels or lots of land  
situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina and  
City and County of Greenville, in Ward two of said City and  
being hereinafter designated as lots numbers 75 and  
76, according to a plat thereof made by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor  
bearing date July 1911 and recorded in plat book A  
at page 145 rec'd. this office R. M. C. for said County and State  
said lots as a whole having the following metes  
and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on Terrace  
Street, joint corner of lots No. 74 and 75 & running  
thence along joint lines of lots No. 74 and 75 N. 57° 26' E.  
10 feet to a stake on J. St. Merritt's line, thence along  
J. St. Merritt's line S. 34° 24' E. 60 feet to a stake, joint corner  
of lots No. 76 and 77, thence along joint lines of lots  
No. 76 and 77 S. 57° 26' N. 70 feet to a stake on Terrace  
Street, thence along Terrace Street N. 26° 29' W. 60 feet to the beginning  
corner thence two of the lots which were conveyed  
to W. P. Davidson by Oliver Sloan Aug. 16, 1913 and recorded in  
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in vol. 21 at page  
157 recorded on the 23rd day of Aug. 1913, and being the same  
lot of land, conveyed to me by W. P. Davidson by his deed  
dated June 14th 1920 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for  
Greenville County in vol. 31 page 16.)

Also all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being  
in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South  
Carolina on the east side of Terrace Street and having  
the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin  
east side of Terrace Street and running along said street 4 1/2 feet  
to an iron pin, thence along said Terrace Street S. 26° 29' E. 19 feet  
inches to an iron pin, thence in a northeasterly direction 70 feet to an  
iron pin, thence in a northwesterly direction along line of the J. St. Merritt  
property 19 feet and 6 inches to an iron pin, thence in a westerly  
direction 5 1/2 feet and 1 inch to the beginning. The above lot being  
more fully described as lot No. 74 as shown on plat of the J. St.  
Merritt property a sub-division plat of which is recorded  
in R. M. C. Office in and for Greenville County South Carolina  
and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by G. W.  
Merritt by his deed dated Dec. 6, 1913 and recorded in  
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in vol. 22 at page 55.)  
Also all that certain piece parcel or tract or tracts of land  
lying situate and being in Greenville Township, Ward no. 2, City of  
Greenville State and County aforesaid, being known and designated  
as lots nos. 70, 71, 72 and 73 on Slice Street as shown by plat  
of Mosley and Deegan property made by R. E. Dalton, July 1911,  
reference to which is made for a more description, and being  
the same lots of land conveyed to me by G. W. McDade by his deed dated  
Jan. 2, 1920 and recorded in the C. M. C. Office for Greenville County in  
vol. 73 at page 371.

on the day of 1920, deed recorded in office of Register  
of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant.
