the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. M. Moore all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situated being in the County aforesaid and described in Greenville Township on the National Highway, being at the intersection about three miles from the Greenville city court house known and designated as lot no. 1 and 2 of the subdivision of a tract of Eaststone acres according to plat made by Archibald Derry Co. Engrs. May 1, 1926, in company with others in the said National Highway at the corner of the Willis property and running thence with line of Willis property east west to corner of said tract to corner of lot no. 6, thence with line of lot no. 6 east and south 300 feet to point in line of lot no. 3 thence with line of lot no. 3, 295 feet to corner on National Highway thence with said National Highway 300 feet to the beginning corner and 1/2 acre containing 3.02 acres.

The grantee herein is to have all water connections and privileges in connection thereto, as far as the Grantee's rights or interests extend.
