Beginning at the corner where the road side
of Edgewood Street adjoins at a point 170 feet in a
line from the corner of the intersection of Edgewood
Street and Lincoln Street, running thence 36 ft.
E. S. W. to a stone fence 10 ft. N. 30° E. feet to
a stone wall corner of property of Mrs. Mary
McGehee, thence N. 18° 15' E. 10.5 feet to a
corner of a common boundary thence north laid down
to the S. E. end of the front of beginning
at the intersection line of 170 feet in width
and 36 ft. E. S. W. to a line of trees from
the corner of the above 170 ft. adjoining lot to the
front of the house described
