TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said *Pauline M. Epstein*,  
her heirs, and assigns, forever.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Pauline M. Epstein, all of my right, title and interest, being an undivided one-half interest in and to the following tracts of land viz:-  
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the North side of Oscar Street between Mayberry Street and an alley running parallel with Westfield Street and having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on the Northwest corner of an alley and Oscar Street and running thence with Oscar Street approximately N. 71 1/4 W. 300 feet to an iron pipe on Oscar Street, thence approximately N. 18 1/2 E. 172.5 feet to an iron pipe, thence approximately S. 67 1/2 E. 300 feet to an iron pipe on alley; thence with said alley approximately S. 18 1/2 W. 150 feet to the beginning. Being known as lots nos. 9, 10, & 11 of Westfield lands, and being the same, later conveyed to the grantor and grantee here-in by T. C. Gower, by deed dated April 13, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book volume 70, page 558.  
Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward 8 of the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe at the Northeast corner of Hudson and Oscar Streets and running thence N. 23-45 E. 136.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 57-06 E. 132 feet to a stake; thence S. 65-0 E. 124.5 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of a 17 foot alley; thence with line of said alley S. 20-57 W. 166.7 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of said alley with Oscar Street; thence with Oscar Street N. 55-12 W. 268 feet to an iron pipe the beginning corner.  
Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the south side of Oscar Street: Beginning at a point on Oscar Street 54 feet west of the corner of Mayfield and Oscar Street and running thence with Oscar Street N. 54-52 W. 12.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 23-30 W. 98.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 54-6 E. 22 feet to the corner of an alley; thence N. 35-08 E. 8 feet to rear corner of lot nos. 3; thence S. 54-0 E. with line of an 8 foot alley 79 feet to rear corner of lots nos. 172; thence N. 35-08 E. 90.1 feet to an iron pipe on Oscar Street; the beginning corner, being lots nos. 2, 3, 4 & 5 as shown on revised plat of property of Parish & Gower by P. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated August, 1919, and recorded in Plat Book C, page 143, and being the same lots of land conveyed to the grantor and grantee herein by W. G. Parish and T. C.
