of Block 1; Lots numbers 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12, of

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, of Block 7; Lots numbers 7, 8, 9 and 10 of

Tract number 2, all that certain tract of land ad-
joining the above described tract, containing twelve
(12) acres, more or less, and bounded by lands now or
formerly of T. G. Donaldson, Anderson Wright, Elisha
Smith, and Cain Franklin.
