and their successors in office, all that
piece, tract or lot of land, lying and being
in Chick Springs Township, County and State
aforesaid, on the south side and near
a farm road leading from Town of Taylors
by the residence of Rees Bennett, G. J. Bonnin,
and about two hundred yards south of the
Northern Rail Road, being the lot on which
the School House building stands, and lot
No. 3 of Colored School House Lot divided by
J. E. Freeman Sept. 15, 1927 and having the following
