KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That Chicora Bank, a Corporation by J. W. Kelly, President and W. T. Martin Vice President, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business at Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the premises and the sum of Three DOLLARS.

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

J. W. Kelly his heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain tract of land situate in Calhoun Township, State and County aforesaid, about two miles South of Peasey, on the West side of Hollingshead Road, containing Thirtieth Seven and one-half ( $37\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres, more or less, being tract number 2, of the sub-division of the lands of the late Mr. Newlands R. Anderson deceased, as shown by a plat made by F. W. Harris, Jr. Nov. 28th, 1913 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Title Book 6, at page 74 to 77 inclusive, said tract of land is also described by deed given to Chicora Bank by L. R. Dean, Feb. 1912, and recorded in Book 79, at page 280.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his

heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and his

heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
