TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Tryon Development Company has subdivided a certain tract of land in the State and County aforesaid into parcels or lots, surrounding a projected lake to be known as Lake Lanier; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire for the benefit of their own property, and for the benefit of future purchasers and owners of the land shown within the lines of the plat hereinafter referred to, that the same shall be developed, and for a time hereafter used exclusively for residential purposes with certain exceptions and subject to certain reservations, conditions and restrictions hereinafter set out;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Tryon Development Company, a corporation, duly organized and chartered under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, in consideration of the above recitals and of the covenants herein and of the sum of

to it in hand paid by Olive J. Ashworth + Christabel H. Sawyer has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, (subject, nevertheless, to the exceptions, reservations, conditions and restrictions hereinafter set out), unto the said Olive J. Ashworth + Christabel H. Sawyer

All that lot, piece or parcel of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Number 100

of Plat Number 1 of the property of the Tryon Development Company, known as LAKE LANIER, made by George Kershaw, C. E., and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance for Greenville County, in

Plat Book Number Page said lot having a frontage of

feet, a rear width of

feet, and a depth of

feet on one line and

feet on the other, as will more fully appear from the said plat, reference being hereby made to the record thereof for a more particular description of the lot herewith conveyed.

Beginning at a point in the center line of Hamilton Place at a distance 348.0 feet more or less from its eastern intersection with the Clark Road, said beginning point being located exactly 39.5 feet eastward from the beginning of a circular curve to the right described by said center line with a radius of 183.0, said beginning of curve being duly referenced by two concrete monuments as shown on aforesaid plat, and running thence along a line drawn at an angle of 85 degrees and 32 minutes to the right from said center line a distance of 143.0 feet northward more or less to the extreme southern corner of Lot 106, thence along a line perpendicular to the last described line northwestward a distance of 50.0 feet to the extreme western point of Lot 106, thence along a line parallel to the first described line to an intersection with the center line of said Hamilton Place a distance of 140.0 feet more or less, thence southward along the center line of said Hamilton Place to the beginning a distance of 50.0 feet, saving and excepting a strip of land adjacent to the center line of Hamilton Place, bounded by a line to the south of parallel to and 15.0 feet distant from the center line of said road, which strip of land is reserved for use by the public as a street, and be it understood that all distances described as curved lines are to be measured in chords of 25.0 feet or fractional parts, and that the said lot has a width at the building line of 50.0 feet.

TOGETHER with the right of enjoyment of privileges and facilities afforded by Lake Lanier, an artificial water, as projected on said plat, for lawful aquatic sports, boating, bathing, swimming and fishing; and together with the further right to erect for the use of the owner of the above described lot a boat house and wharf or landing at some appropriate location on the margin of said Lake, the said location and the size, plans and specifications of said boat house and wharf or landing to be subject to approval of grantor; but nothing herein contained shall privilege a nuisance or license the pollution of the said Lake, its inlets, outlets, or beaches, nor authorize any misfeasant, offensive or boisterous conduct, or the use of the said Lake by any person inexperienced in swimming; it being expressly stipulated that the grantor herein, its shareholders or successors, shall not be liable to any lot owner or any other person for any damage or injury sustained in the exercise of the said privileges and facilities, or by reason hereof.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, All and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Olive J. Ashworth + Christabel H. Sawyer, their heirs and assigns.

And the said Tryon Development Company, does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Olive J. Ashworth + Christabel H. Sawyer, their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors and all persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

This conveyance is made subject to the following conditions, restrictions and covenants running with the land, for a violation of the first of which the title shall immediately revert to the grantor, its successors or assigns, except as against lien creditors, to-wit:

FIRST: That the property hereby conveyed, or any part thereof, is not to be sold, rented, leased or otherwise disposed of to any person of African descent.

SECOND: That the property hereby conveyed, or any part thereof, is to be used for residential purposes only for a period of Twenty-one years after April 1, 1925, but this shall not be taken to prevent the grantor herein from designating certain lots of this development or any future addition thereto for business purposes or for other purposes desirable in the opinion of grantor, in promoting said development, the right to do so being hereby expressly reserved by grantor.

THIRD: That no use shall be made of any lot which, in the opinion of the grantor herein, will constitute a nuisance, or prove in any way noxious or offensive to the neighboring inhabitants, or injure the value of neighboring lots.

FOURTH: That no dwelling house shall be built on the above described lot to cost less than Three Thousand Dollars; that no residence, garage, or other building whatsoever shall be erected on said lot until, and unless, the plans and specifications thereof have been submitted to and approved by the grantor herein, or its successors; that the buildings on said land shall be erected on or within the building line, or the house location, as the case may be, as shown and indicated on the plat hereinafore referred to, and in strict accord with the plans and specifications so required to be submitted and approved, and shall face or front on the street or road on which the lot herewith conveyed is shown to front by the plat aforesaid.

FIFTH: That not more than one residence shall be erected on each lot or parcel as shown by said plat, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in addition to one and residence built thereon, of slightly appearance and appropriate location, within the building line and not nearer than five feet to any side or back line of any adjoining lot not owned by the owner of the land hereinabove described.

SIXTH: That the parties hereto, their successors, heirs and assigns, will not, during the term of twenty-one years from April 1, 1925, subdivide, sell or convey any part or parcel of any lot within said block, in connection and merged with any adjoining lot, so as to create one or more lots of larger area than as shown on said plat, and the further right to determine the size and shape of lots sold for other than residential purposes.

SEVENTH: That the grantor herein reserves the right to lay, erect and maintain, or authorize the laying, erecting and maintaining of sewer, gas, and water pipes, electric conduits or pipes, telegraph, telephone and electric light poles, and any other such public utilities, on or in any of the roadways, streets or alleys bordering said property, with connecting links for the same along the back and side lines of the lot above described, and to grade surface, and repair the said roadways, streets and alleys, without compensation to any lot owner for any damage sustained thereby.

EIGHTH: That no surface closet or other unsanitary device for the disposal of sewage shall ever be installed or maintained on the lot herewith conveyed, and the grantor herein agrees that upon the written request of the owner of said lot made at any time within three years after the date of execution of this deed, grantor will install on said lot a septic tank, or other sanitary device for disposal of sewage, and said owner shall have the right to connect to and use the same; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in such event, grantor is to have the right, without reimbursement to the owner of said lot, to connect to said septic tank or other sanitary device one or more owners of other lots, or grant them the right to so connect, according to the capacity of said septic tank or other sanitary device.
