did on the 21st day of November, 1925, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is, Re-Bilt Tire and Rubber Company Inc.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is, Greenville, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is,
